ADVENTURE TRAILS DOG CAMP GUIDELINES

We will strive to do our very best to provide a safe and fun environment for your dog and we need your help to succeed. Remember, we love and cherish your dog as much as our own. We honor the trust you place in us by being transparent. The following are guidelines for you to read and agree to while your dog is at Adventure Trails Dog Camp:

- I certify that my dog is in good health and has not been ill with any communicable condition within the last 30 days.
- I understand that I am solely responsible for any harm caused by my dog while at Adventure Trails Dog Camp.
- I understand and agree that Adventure Trails Dog Camp will not be held responsible for accidents, fires, or any other causes beyond the control of the provider.
- I further understand and agree that Adventure Trails Dog Camp and its staff and volunteers will not be liable for any problems which develop, provided responsible care and precautions are followed, and I hereby release them of any liability of any kind whatsoever arising from my dog's attendance and participation at Adventure Trails Dog Camp.
- I further understand and agree that any problems which develop with my dog will be treated as deemed "best fit" by staff and volunteers of Adventure Trails Dog Camp at their sole discretion, and that I assume full financial responsibility for any and all expenses involved.
- I further understand and agree that, should my dog jump the fence and be picked up by animal control, I am solely responsible for paying any fees or penalties incurred.
- I further understand and agree that if my dog chooses to bite or become aggressive towards other dogs or the staff of Adventure Trails Dog Camp, my dog will be asked to leave.
- If your dog is shy or very excitable bring them in early before all of the dogs are at camp. That way they can come in and settle in as dogs enter. They can be the sniffer rather than the sniffee. Remember that our latest drop off is 11:00AM.
- Feed your dog at least an hour before she comes to camp. Your dog is going to super active and with a full stomach plus high activity there is a chance of bloat.
- You are welcome to bring a lunch that we can feed your dog. Even adults might want a lunch that don't normally eat lunch, due to the high use of calories. It helps for them to take a little food and a nap or rest if they are at camp all day.

- Make sure your vaccinations are kept current. Please bring a copy showing that information for our file. We will request it at the beginning of the year.
- Get a fecal check every six months to keep everyone parasite free.
- If your dog is showing symptoms of illness like coughing, nasal discharge or excessive diarrhea please keep her home so that she doesn't spread a possible illness and because if a dog comes when she isn't feeling good she is unhappy, grumpy and more likely to get in a fight.
- If you have a small dog please drive up to the small dog yard to prevent the large dogs from getting over excited by seeing the unknown dog going past their fence.
- Keep your dog on lead so your dog isn't running up on a small dog/large dog that is entering at their yard or run the fence and getting the other dogs excited.
- Having a coat for very cold or very rainy weather makes for a more comfortable experience for your dog. If you don't have a coat we will put a camp coat on your dog. Ask us if you are interested in getting a coat. We have tested many and know what is the best for camp.
- If you want to know how your dog is doing at any time just text me. I will gladly give an update and even send a picture or video to you.
- If you will be later than 5:30pm please let us know when you drop off or text me or call. It helps me not wait until the last minute and worry that something has gone wrong. Camp is open until 6 if you need, but most dogs are gone by 5pm. Late fees are applied every 1/4 hours.
- Our routine is generally 7-9am is dogs coming in and playing fetch. About 9pm to 9:30pm we go on the back 4 acres of trails in the woods and again about 11am. Lunch is served at 11:30am and dogs are put together with friends in the kennel runs to rest for an hour. After lunch around 1pm we go on trails again. If we do the field trip it is normally 2pm or 3pm. Field trip is going to the back 5 acre property which is fenced also. If there are no small dogs in that yard we do a couple of exploring in that yard.
- Just for your peace of mind please know that we watch your dog for signs of stress, illness or changes in behavior and will report it to you. If your dog is injured I will contact you ASAP. We have a good first aid kit and are CPR Certified. Our priority is safety.
- You may find your dog becomes a celebrity when we use their photo on social media, music videos and advertisements. We don't accept responsibility if it goes to their heads.
